

## PERSONAL DATA HANDLING INFORMATION

Pursuant to Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of April 27, 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data (...) (the “General Regulation”), hereinafter referred to as “RODO”, Jagiellonian University (hereafter referred to as UJ) informs that:

1. The administrator of your personal data is Jagiellonian University, Gołębia Street 24, 31-007 Kraków.

2. Data Protection Inspector has been appointed at the University, 4 Czapskich St, 31-110 Kraków, room no. 27. Contact with the Inspector is provided Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and by e-mail: [iod@uj.edu.pl](mailto:iod@uj.edu.pl).

3. Your personal data will be processed for:

a) performance of the contract, the subject of which is participation in the 65. Cracow School of Theoretical Physics and also for the purpose of registration of participation in the School on the basis of the contract, the subject of which is participation in the School (Article 6(1)(b) of the DPA). The in-person event is organized in June 14- 21, 2005.

b) with regard to personal data in the form of image processed in pursuit of the legitimate interest of the Organizer - i.e. for promotional, informational, documentary, archival purposes on the basis of Article 6(1)(f) RODO in connection with the Act of February 4, 1994 on Copyright and Related Rights;

c) to ensure security during the School in accordance with the UJ's Video Surveillance Regulations available at <https://bip.uj.edu.pl/> and the Information Obligation concerning image processing in video surveillance available at <https://iod.uj.edu.pl/monitoring-wizyjny> on the basis of Article 6(1)(e) of the RODO - with regard to video surveillance data.

4. Your provision of personal data:

a) with respect to the data referred to in section 3.a) above is necessary for the conclusion of the contract and participation in the 65. Cracow School of Theoretical Physics;

b) with respect to the data referred to in section 3.b) above is voluntary;

c) with respect to the data referred to in sect. 3.c) above is voluntary, but failure to provide them - due to the obligation to ensure the safety of Participants - results in the inability to participate in the School.

5. The recipients of your personal data are entities providing IT support in the organization of the School.

6. Your personal data provided in the registration form will not be shared with third parties. Your personal data in the form of image may be recorded on photos or videos of the School and processed on the UJ website and UJ profiles on social networking sites in a manner that allows access by third parties, for purposes related to the promotion of UJ.
7. Your personal data will not be transferred to third countries (outside the European Economic Area) or to international organizations other than your home institution.
8. Your personal data provided in the registration form will be processed until the end of June 2025, and then for the period of limitation of claims that may arise from participation in the School. Your personal data in the form of image will be processed as part of the coverage of the event on UJ websites and UJ profiles on social networks until you file an objection. Video surveillance data will be processed for a maximum of 3 months.
9. You have the right to: access to the content of your data and their rectification, erasure (unless further processing is necessary for the performance of a legal obligation or for the establishment, investigation or defense of claims), restriction of data processing and portability.
10. Your personal data will not be subject to automated decision-making or profiling.
11. You have the right to file a complaint with the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection when you consider that the processing of your personal data is carried out in violation of the provisions of the General Regulation.
